

All About Route 25 Thurston/MCC

As part of our ongoing effort to provide safe, reliable, and convenient public transportation, we asked customers for input on Route 12 in Fall 2014. Based upon the feedback we received, we're proposing to combine RTS Routes 12 and 2 to form Route 25 Thurston/MCC.

Route 25 Thurston/MCC will:

- More than double weekday trips between the 19th Ward and Monroe Community College
- Add new weekend service between the 19th Ward and Monroe Community College
- Extend service along the route to Brighton-Henrietta Townline Rd.

How Route 25 Thurston/MCC May Affect Your Commute:

- Route 25 will continue to provide service between the RTS Transit Center and the 19th Ward.
- The area covered by Route 2 that would not be covered by Route 25 would continue to receive service via these RTS route:
 - Brook Ave. and Genesee Park Blvd. covered by Route 28
- The areas covered by Route 12 that would not be covered by Route 25 would continue to receive service via these RTS routes:
 - Genesee St. covered by Route 4
 - Chili Ave. covered by Routes 8
 - East Henrietta Rd. between Mt. Hope and Westfall Rd covered by Route 24

Customers may take one of the routes listed above, or walk up to 0.5 miles to ride a Route 25 bus.

• No bus stops would be eliminated by Route 25.
